Monongalia County Schools embraces the importance of hands-on learning, student choice, and cross curricular learning. A choice board for middle school has been created for students to fulfill their requirements for attendance on the at-home learning days. - Students will be required to complete **four** of the activities on the choice board which will be documented by an adult's initials in each activity box that is completed.
- Students will also be expected to write **one** letter to introduce themselves to their new teachers. In this letter, students should tell their teachers about what they hope to achieve in the upcoming school year along with anything they should know, like special talents or interests.

The initialed choice board and the letter should be returned to the school at the beginning of the year either at orientation or on the first day of school.

In order to facilitate the transition of 5th graders to middle school, they will also be completing the middle school choice board. Incoming 6th grade students will receive a copy of the choice board during step-up day on June 2nd. If extra copies are needed, they will be available in all elementary and middle school offices and middle school websites.
